This should be a thoughtful paragraph that reveals your emotions, strengths, and things you may want to work on as a learner. Your artifact reflections may be pretty open, as long as you are thinking deeply about your learning process.

There is a list of reflection questions below.

- Choose at least 3 YELLOW questions to respond to in complete sentences
- Choose ONE BLUE SKILL to reflect on.
- In total your reflection paragraph should be about 5-8 sentences long.

General Reflection Questions:

CHOOSE AT LEAST 3 YELLOW questions below to answer in COMPLETE SENTENCES.

Process Reflection:

- How much did you know about the subject before we started?
- What process did you go through to produce this artifact?
- In what ways have you gotten better at this kind of work?

Inward Looking Reflection:

- How do you feel about this artifact? What parts of it do you particularly like? Dislike? Why? What did/do you enjoy most about this piece of work?

Outward Looking Reflection:

- Did you do your work the way other people did theirs?
- In what ways did you do your work differently? Similarly?

Future Reflection:

- What would you change if you had a chance to create this artifact again?
- What's the one thing that you have seen in a classmate's work or process that you would like to try in creating your next artifact?
