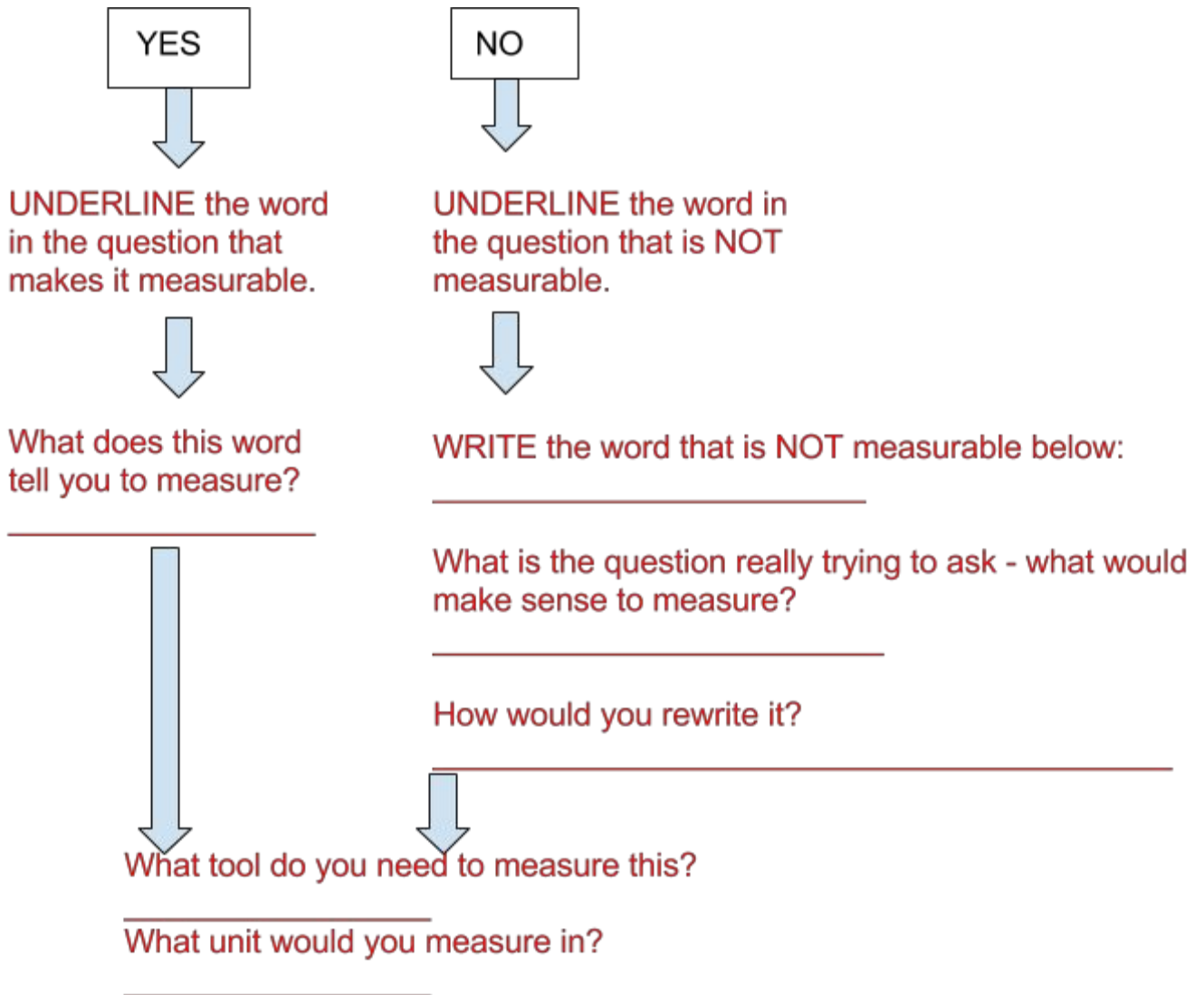
Measurement	Tool	Unit

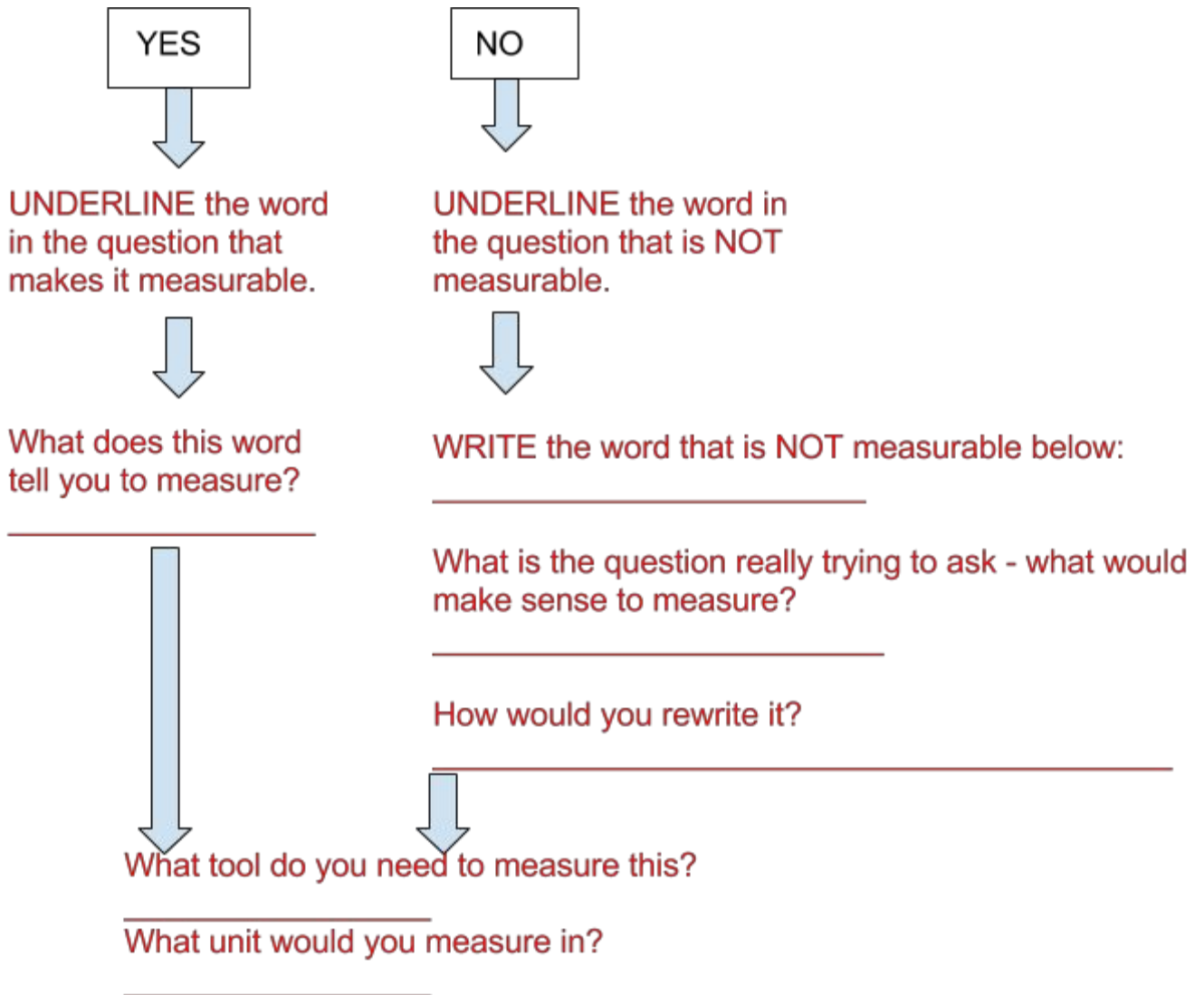


Example 2

2) CIRCLE if it is measurable:

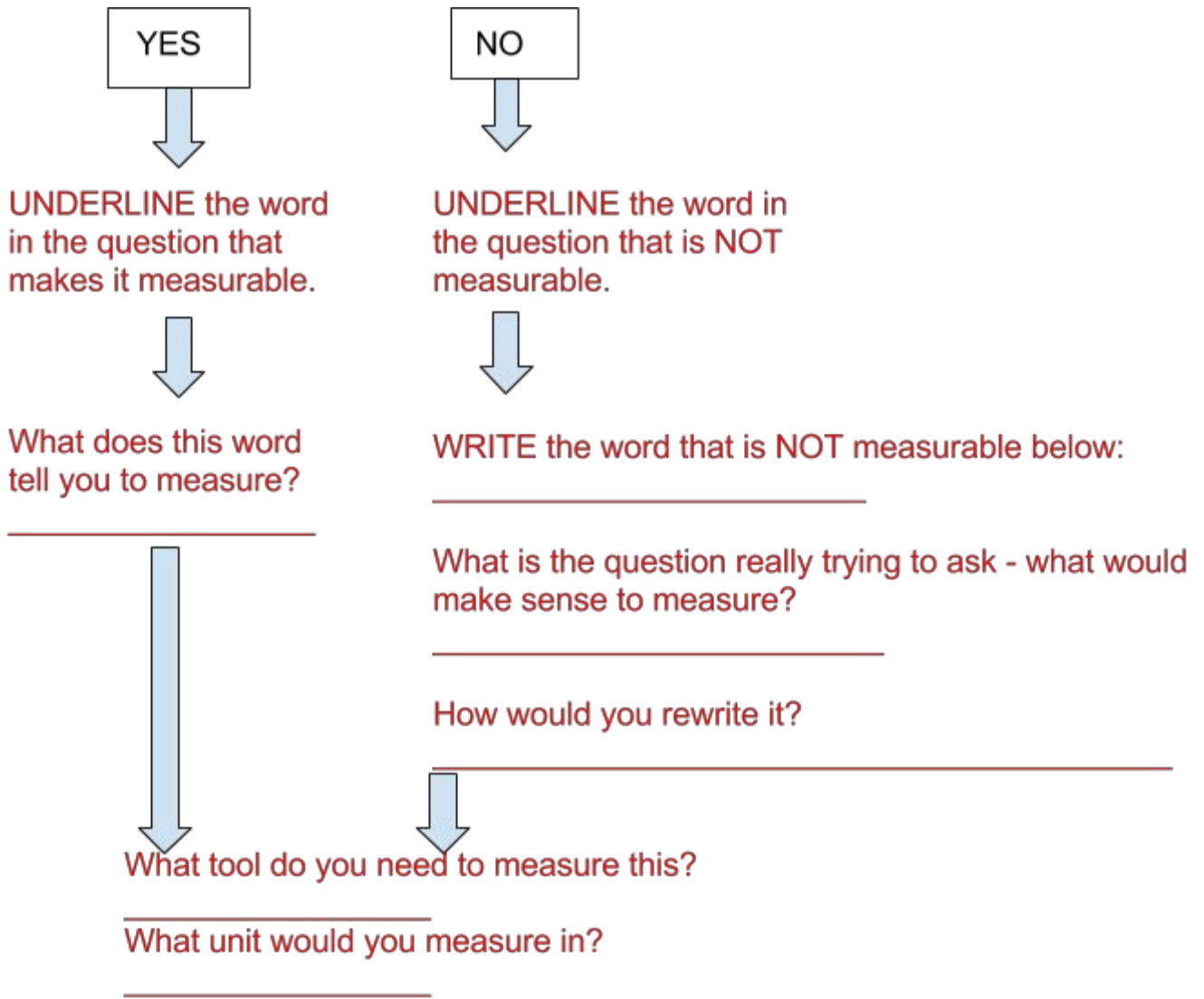


Example 3

2) CIRCLE if it is measurable:

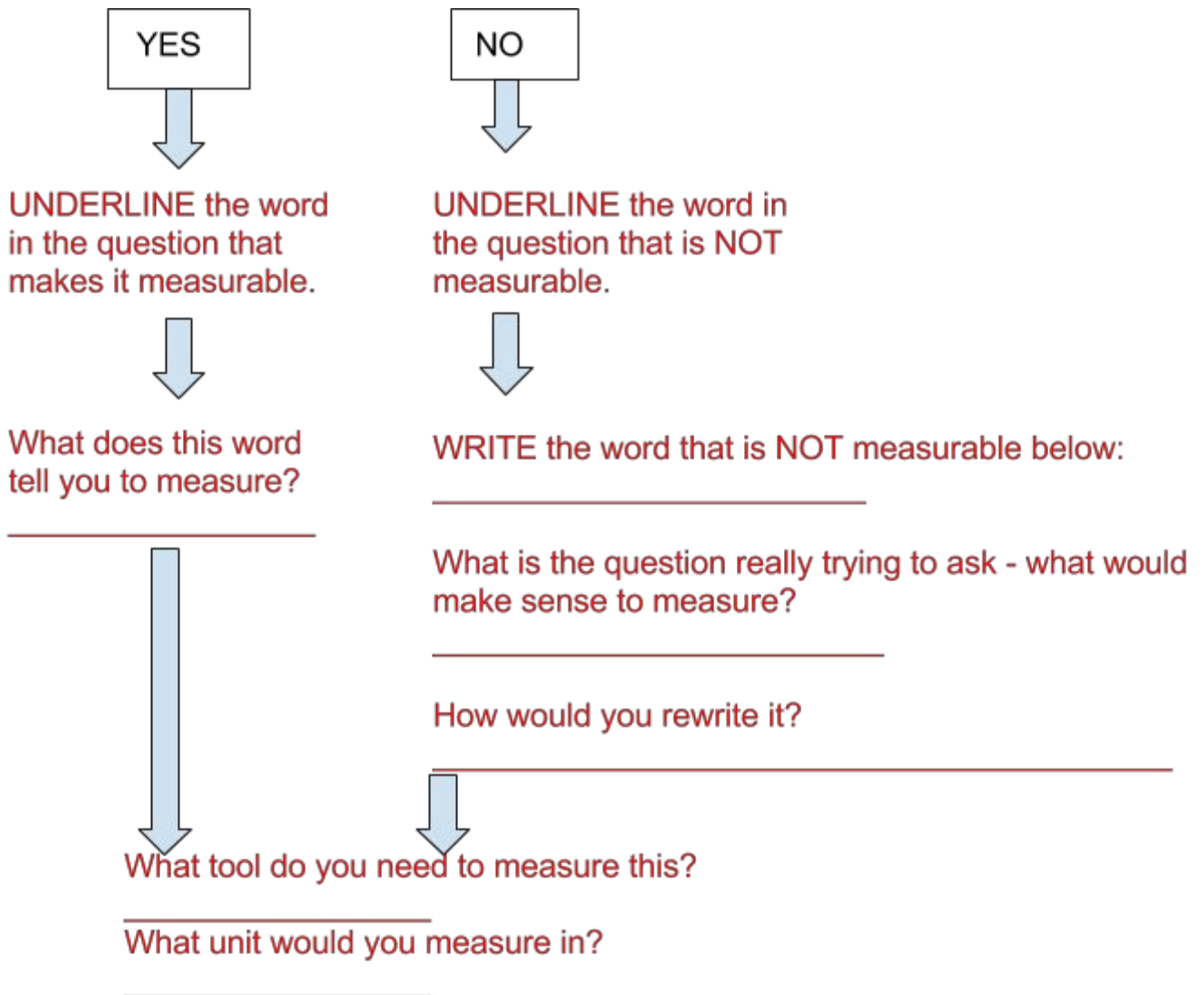

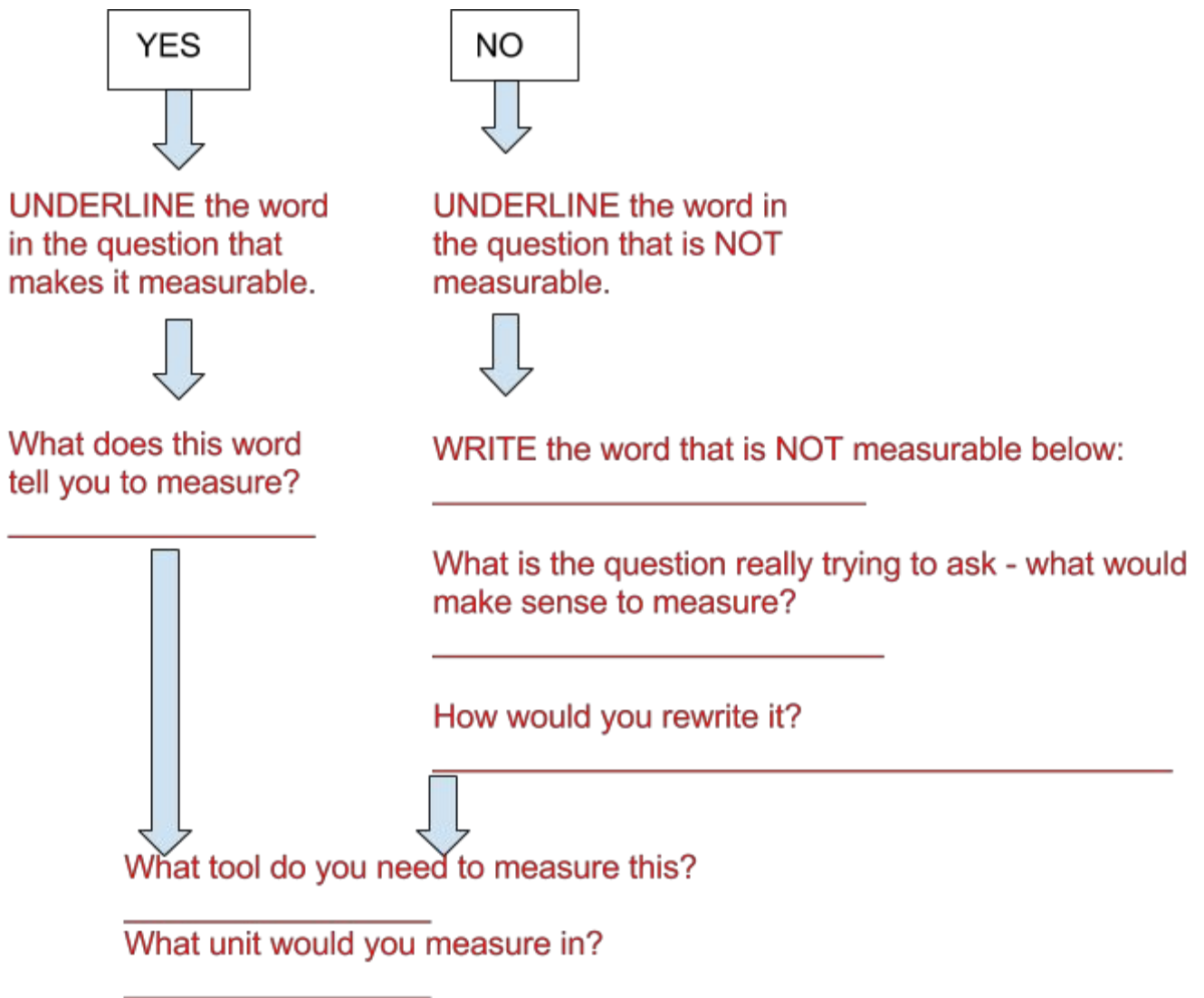
